Membership,

The 2005 contract fair share issue has been resolved. The amount is \$12.48 per month or \$149.76. This amount has been reviewed by attorney David Osborne of Hamilton & Faatz as well as current and previous board members. All agree that the above is fair and accurate. The Aurora Lodge of the FOP will not support any further individual grievances or actions against the amount of fair share requested by the Aurora Police Association.

The payment period established for fair share for the 2005 contract was from June of 2005 thru May of 2006. If you were not a member of the APA during that time, you are responsible for payment even if you were a member of the APA thru May of 2005. Any FOP members that were APA members during part of the payment period can deduct the months that APA membership dues were paid. Additionally, any member that paid the \$75.00 assessment that was directed toward the contract arbitration can deduct that from the amount owed.

Since the payment period has expired, the APA is requesting that any amount owed is paid in full. The FOP board recommends and urges all members to pay the fair share that they owe. Copies of all documentation used to determine the fair share amount are available for review. Please contact me with questions.
