AGREEMENT

Pursuant to the Fair Share language in the collective bargaining agreement between the Aurora Police Association (APA) and the City of Aurora and the procedures adopted by the APA, the APA sent a notice to all persons covered by the agreement setting forth the fair share amount for the period June 1, 2005 through May 31, 2006. Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #49 (Lodge #49) filed an objection to the calculation on behalf of its members. The parties have been in discussion over the objection and have come to the following agreement.


1. The APA will modify the calculation by making the Board expenses chargeable at the administrative percentage chargeable. It will also re-characterize the cost of the Internal Affairs Seminar to non-chargeable.
2. As a result of these changes, the percentage of chargeable expenses becomes 45.88% or \$12.48 per month per all fair share participants. The fair share amount will be calculated using this percentage for the period June 1, 2005 through May 31, 2006.
3. The APA agrees that Board expenses will be charged at the administrative percent chargeable in the future and that seminars dealing with internal affairs, or portions of seminars that deal with internal affairs as well as matters germane to collective bargaining, will not be considered chargeable.
4. Lodge #49 will withdraw the objection it filed on behalf of its members and agrees that it will not fund any challenge to the recalculated amount for 2005-06.
